



Sorority Recruitment 101

Congratulations on your graduation! As you enter college, we hope that you will consider joining a sorority as they provide sisterhood, scholarship, service, and support. Recruitment is governed by the College Panhellenic at your respective college or university. Some campuses have recruitment throughout the academic year; others may have a primary recruitment period once a year.

To participate in New Member Sorority Recruitment in 2021-22, **YOU MUST REGISTER** with your **College or University Panhellenic Association**. Check out your University's Greek Life website and/or call for their requirements and deadlines. Once you register, **be sure to check your campus e-mail daily as that is how your Panhellenic will contact you.**

Due to changes on your campus due to COVID—19, Panhellenic Recruitment may occur with on-line and in-person opportunities for you to meet the sorority women. Regardless of the format, be your authentic self and smile. Ask questions to learn more about the young women in the chapter, their philanthropy, scholarship, and leadership opportunities—things that are important to you when making friends. Take notes, and keep an open mind.

Recommendations will serve as your introduction to the chapter for the 2021-22 academic year. Check your Greek Life website to see which chapters are on the campus. Use your network of friends, your parents' friends, teachers, counselors, coaches, etc., to see if they know women who are members of those sororities, also, who might write a recommendation on your behalf. If there are sororities for which you cannot find an alumnae in your network, let us know as soon as possible but no later than **July 10th**, and we will try our best to do what we can to assist you. - Your senior photo, and one optional additional photo; in .jpg format only
- A list of the sororities for which you will need recommendations
