The individual providing a Personal reference should be someone unrelated to the applicant who can comment about her involvement in her NPC group. Examples might include a chapter adviser, or a regional, national, or international officer of her sorority. The Personal reference should not be a peer. The Academic reference letter should be written by someone whom an applicant knows through her college work, such as a professor, academic adviser, coach, etc. The person writing this Academic reference letter **should not** be a fellow student.
